## Statement to Congressional Leadership: Do Not Expand Funding for Immigration Detention in the FY24 Spending Bill March 13, 2024

The undersigned organizations advocate for the human rights of immigrant communities and for a fair, functioning and humane immigration system. We urge Members of Congress to ensure that the FY2024 spending bill for the Department of Homeland Security does *not increase* funding for Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) detention beyond FY2023's already high levels.

Immigration detention is part of a <u>deterrent-oriented</u> approach to immigration policy that imposes <u>punishing conditions</u> of confinement on people navigating the immigration adjudication system. As decades of data <u>show</u>, increasing the use of detention does not in any way solve the challenges at the border nor does it impact the number of people coming to seek safety in the United States.

ICE's detention system consists of a network of more than 100 private prisons and county jails where <u>abuses are rampant</u>, including an <u>increasing use of solitary confinement</u>, and oversight mechanisms are <u>severely compromised</u>. Last year <u>ICE itself identified</u> at least nine facilities that require immediate closure or downsizing due to <u>unsafe conditions</u> and <u>egregious violations</u>, but nevertheless most <u>remain open today</u>. Expanding immigration detention will endanger the lives and safety of thousands and cost taxpayers millions.

ICE currently receives \$2.8 billion in funding at FY2023 levels to detain approximately 34,000 people daily. ICE is *currently detaining* around 39,000 people daily, regularly over-spending their congressionally approved appropriated funds. It is irresponsible for Congress to reward ICE's <u>chronic</u> disregard for its appropriated budget. Historically, the *only* time ICE has been funded to detain more than 34,000 people daily was during the four years of the Trump administration. The White House's budget requests for FY2023 and FY2024 sought funding for an average of 25,000 daily detention beds.

With cuts being considered across the entirety of the federal government, we urge Congress to direct funds toward the critical needs of all people, not toward expanded incarceration.
